QNUK Level 3 Award in First Aid at Work (RQF) 3 day (18hr) course



Overview

This course meets HSE requirements to provide first aid in the workplace, including higher risk environments and lower risk workplaces with a high number of employees. It provides the skills and knowledge to act in a first aid emergency, and continue to provide help confidently until qualified personnel arrive. It is usually delivered over 3 consecutive days although the course can be spread out over up to 10 weeks. It can be delivered in your workplace with a minimum of 6 delegates or individual places can be booked on open courses and is suitable for new or experienced first aiders. It can be completed as a face to face course or blended where 6hrs is completed online and the other 12 hours face to face. If you hold an in-date qualification you may requalify in 12 hours.

Qualification Assessment

To obtain the qualification delegates are required to:

- ⌘ attend the full 18hrs of the course (or blended 6hrs online / 12hrs face to face, or 12 hrs for the qualification)
- ⌘ demonstrate practical skills for the topics marked with *; and
- ⌘ score a minimum 28/40 on the multiple choice test at the end of the course.

Course Combinations

This course can be combined with Paediatric First Aid. These qualifications enable workplaces to meet the HSE workplace first aid requirements and the Ofsted EYFS requirements on the same course. For guidance on which combination suits your setting best please contact us.
