QNUK Level 3 Award in Paediatric First Aid (RQF) 6hrs online + 6hrs classroom—blended



Overview

This course meets all Ofsted / EYFS requirements for professional childcarers and schools, and provides the confidence, skills and knowledge to act in a first aid emergency. The qualification is also suitable for parents and carers, babysitters, nannies and au pairs and others who work with children. Delegates complete 6hrs online learning followed by 6hrs in the classroom, typically over one day. It can be delivered in your setting with a minimum of 6 delegates or individual places can be booked on open courses and is suitable for new or experienced first aiders although we recommend a traditional 12hr face to face course if you are completely new to first aid.

Qualification Assessment

To obtain the qualification delegates are required to:

- ⌘ complete the e-learning prior to the classroom course date;

- ⌘ score a minimum 28/40 on the multiple choice test at the end of the course.



Course Combinations

This course can be combined with Emergency First Aid at Work (EFAW) with the addition of adult resuscitation and choking or First Aid at Work (FAW) with the addition of a further 6 hours.
