QNUK Level 3 Award in Paediatric First Aid (RQF) 2 day (12hr) course



Overview

This course meets all Ofsted / EYFS requirements for professional childcarers and schools, and provides the confidence, skills and knowledge to act in a first aid emergency. The qualification is also suitable for parents and carers, babysitters, nannies and au pairs and others who work with children and is typically delivered over two consecutive days. It can be delivered in your setting with a minimum of 6 delegates or individual places can be booked on open courses and is suitable for new or experienced first aiders. This course is 100% tutor-led with no requirement for learning outside the classroom.

Qualification Assessment

To obtain the qualification delegates are required to:

- ⌘ attend the full 12hrs of the course;

- ⌘ score a minimum 28/40 on the multiple choice test at the end of the course.



Course Combinations

This course can be combined with Emergency First Aid at Work (EFAW) with the addition of adult resuscitation and choking or First Aid at Work (FAW) with the addition of a further 6 hours. These qualifications enable settings to meet the HSE workplace first aid requirements. For guidance on which combination suits your setting best please contact us.
